

Giclées are created through a printing method in which an image is first scanned and then digitally enhanced to precisely match the original art. This computerized image is then sent to a high-resolution inkjet printer, which reproduces the image by spraying millions of microscopic droplets of ink onto various substrates to create a print which is extremely faithful to the original.

The media used is a high quality photographic paper, archival acid-free 100% cotton paper or canvas. The superior quality of these giclée prints is comparable to the original art but is substantially more affordable.
